Sprinkler Turn On Basics!!!

Now that Easter has come and gone we know that Spring and Summer have to be right around the corner - even though we keep getting some of those late season storms that feel more like Fall than Spring. But as the ground finally thaws for good we need to get our lawn equipment and sprinkler systems ready for duty. Here are some tips for homeowners and professionals alike:



Watch for hard frost and avoid turning your sprinkler systems too early. The average last hard frost (28 degrees) in Boise is April 24th.

Turn your system on and run each sprinkler zone to purge air from the pipes. Make adjustments and look for any system leaks.

Set your sprinklers to run based on the season. In early Spring our lawns and plants will need less water than in the hot summer months.

The time of day when your sprinklers run is very important. We recommend setting your timer to start watering between 4:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m.

- **Dormant Oil** – We apply a highly refined horticultural oil to protect trees and shrubs from overwintering pests.
- **Early Summer Insect and Mite Spray** - We inspect and treat insects and pests that target your trees and shrubs in early summer.
- **Late Summer Insect and Mite Spray** – This secondary spray is specifically designed to target those pests and insects that thrive in the later season when temperatures begin to peak.
- **Fall Deep Root Feeding** – At the end of the growing season your trees and plants need a balanced fertilizer and nutrient injection deep into the root system to promote health and vigor throughout the winter months.
