We're getting close to saying goodbye to a summer that brought record high temperatures along with near-record low-high temps (remember June 16th when the high temperature of the day was only 64 degrees!). Throw in a couple wind storms and we had a pretty memorable summer.

You may have noticed the grass is growing a little slower and the weeds are not spreading nearly as fast. This is the time of year when we can actually relax a little and enjoy our backyard kingdoms without the threat of all our hard work coming apart. We're getting some cool weather and the grass and plants are loving it.

Here are some tips to get the most out of your landscape between now and the first freeze:

- Seed Your Lawn - This is the best time of the year to seed your lawn. Seed germination is at it's peak with daytime temperature this time of year.
- Divide and Transplant - Most perennial plants can be divided and replanted now while the temperatures are modest and the ground is moist.
- Plant Spring Bulbs - Get your Tulips, Daffodils and Crocus in before the ground turns to ice.
- Remove Downed Leaves - Yes, it looks better. Yes, it's good for your lawn. Hire the neighbor kid if you need to. We don't want Snow Mold, a common fungus that can attack and kill grass smothered by moist deciduous leaves.
- Sprinkler Blowouts - Enough said on this one.
- Fall Deep Root Feeding - Give your trees and plants a boost of energy to make it through the winter.
